Refurbishing a listed building to tight timescale

The Copsewood Trust Atherstone Campus formally the site of The Queen Elizabeth Secondary School in Warwickshire, required complete refurbishment of the three-storey Grade III listed building with bell tower.

One of the greatest challenges was to restore the original look of the school buildings, which included essential timber repairs and re-painting of the rooftop bell tower, which had to be accessed by a bespoke scaffolding system.

A full range of Zenith Refitment Services were contracted to include: minor works design and build for classrooms, washrooms and communal areas, general glazing repairs to the metal casement windows, new resin flooring for shower and change rooms, carpentry, rendering & plastering and finally complimented by internal and external painting and decorating.
